Chief Appraiser Margie Herrin discussed the proposed 2023 NCAD budget with the board members. She stated that insurance was going up, and she had put a five (5) percent increase in salaries for employees in the proposed budget. She stated that all levies went up except for Deweyville ISD and Brookeland ISD. Ms. Herrin discussed the 2023-2024 re-appraisal plan with the board.
